



Advanced Studies Program Frequently Asked Questions:

Why does my child have to audition?

Since all RedEd programs tailor the curriculum to meet the needs of our students, we love to get to know our students a bit before the first day of camp. Student auditions not only allow us to cast the show by the first day, but gives the Director of Education, Artistic Director, and Camp Director a chance to greet each child and learn a little about their interests before they begin to study with our team.

Does the audition determine whether my child “gets into” camp?

No! All students are welcome! In order to get to know our students and create the best curriculum possible, we just want to get to know everyone before the first day of camp.

What should my child audition with?

Anything that they are comfortable performing and makes them feel confident! They can sing any song they like and prepare any monologue they like.

How do I sign up for an audition slot?

Once your child is registered, the Ed. Dept. Coordinator will email you to help you schedule your audition and talk through any questions you have.

When does registration close?

Registration for Advanced Studies closes on May 1st.
